

# Amazing Discovery -10

## Who created God?

### ◆ Introduction

Well, that is a very hard question. To be honest with you I just do not know the answer. That question bothered me too for a long time.

### ◆ Then who knows the answer?

With all the evidences that we have about the uniqueness and authenticity of the Christian's Holy Bible, I strongly believe that God exists and **He holds the answer** to this hard question. God did not reveal His origin in the Holy Bible. No man has ever actually seen God face to face. Men in the past had heard Him speak, saw His glory passing by, but never dared to ask Him the question, "Who created You?"

### • Moses' encounter with God

Here is one such incident recorded in the Bible, Exodus 3:1-6. "One day as Moses was tending the flock, near Mt. Horeb, the mountain of God, suddenly the Angel of Jehovah appeared to him as a flame of fire in a bush. When Moses saw the bush was on fire and that it did not burn up, he went over to investigate. Then God called out to him, "Moses, Moses!" 'Who is it?' Moses asked. "Don't come any closer, God told him." Take off your shoes, for you are standing on holy ground. I am the God of your fathers—the God of Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob." (Moses covered his face with his hands, for he was afraid to look at

God). During the dialogue, God told Moses, v.10, "Come now therefore, and I will send you to Pharaoh that you may bring My people, the children of Israel, out of Egypt." v.13, Moses said to God, "Indeed, when I come to the children of Israel and say to them, 'The God of your fathers has sent me to you,' and they say to me, 'What is His name?' what shall I say to them?" And God said to Moses, "**I AM WHO I AM**". Meaning the self existing One or He has **no beginning or ending**, the **everlasting** God.

Therefore, the only person who knows the answer is God.

Therefore, if we are sincerely searching for the answer we must seek Him with all our heart.

Sometimes it is possible for us to toss aside this matter as of no importance. Either way we are going to meet our Creator God one day. It is better to meet see Him as our Friend than our Judge.

Proverbs 8:28 says, "I love those who love Me, and those who seek Me diligently will find Me."

### • How to meet God?

In the Christians' Holy Bible John Chapter 1, we discover that God came down to live among us to tell us all about Him. It says, Verses 1-3 say, "In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. He was in the beginning with God. All things were made through

Him, and without Him nothing was made that was made."

Verse 14 says, "And the Word became flesh and dwelt among us, and we beheld His glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father, full of grace and truth." Here we discover that He is talking about Jesus the Son of God.

Verse 18 says, "No one has ever actually seen God, but of course, His only Son has, for he is the companion of the Father and has **told us all about Him**." Therefore, only Jesus knows all about God

### • Jesus is the only Way to meet God

In John 14:6 Jesus said, "**I am the Way, and the Truth, and the Life. No one comes to the father but through Me.**"

One day, during 1970s, someone asked me the same question, '**Who created God?**' My answer to him was, 'I do not know. Only God knows the answer. But I discovered that we can **meet God as a friend if we go through Jesus Christ**. Then I asked him, "**Are you sincerely seeking the answer?**" He said, "**Yes**". Taking him at his word, I shared with him the Good News, "How to know God personally through Jesus Christ." Before he left, after receiving Jesus Christ, I told him not to forget to ask that question to God when you meet Him. He gladly agreed.

This question does not bother me any more. Because I know, I will meet God in Heaven when I die. I am also waiting to see Him to find the answer.

## • What about you, my friend?

Are you sincerely searching for the answer? If your answer is 'Yes', here is how you can meet God.

### 1. Agree with God that you have sinned against God and separated from Him.

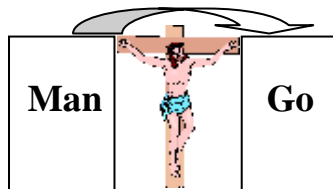
God says in Romans 3:23, "For all (including you and me) have sinned and come short of the glory of God." Romans 6:23, "For the wages of sin is death, (spiritual separation from God)..." (When we disobey God's laws, we sin against God).

### 2. Accept the fact that Jesus had died on the cross in your place to pay the penalty for your sins.

1 Corinthians 15:3-6 says, "Christ died for our sins... He was buried; He was raised on the third day, according to the Scriptures... He appeared to Peter, then to the twelve. After that He appeared to more than five hundred..."

### 3. Trust that Jesus is the only way to God.

John 14:6 says, 'Jesus said, "I am the Way and the Truth and the Life. No one comes to the Father but through Me".'

### 4. Receive Jesus as your personal Saviour and Lord.

John 1:12 says, "But as many as received Him to them He gave the right to become children of God." An intellectual understanding of all these is not enough, but we must individually receive Jesus Christ as our Saviour and Lord, an act of our will.

Jesus said in Revelation 3:20, "Behold I stand at the door and knock. If anyone hears My voice and opens the door, I will come into him..." Jesus needs an invitation from you to enter your life, because He is not a thief. He is Almighty God. He will not force Himself into your life against his will.

#### ◆ Here is a suggested prayer:

"Lord Jesus I need you. I agree that I have sinned against You. I open the door of my life and receive You as my Saviour and Lord. Thank you for forgiving my sins and giving me eternal life. Make me the kind of person you want me to be." Amen.

If this prayer expresses the desire of your Heart, pray this prayer right now and Jesus will come into your life just as He promised. You pray this prayer only one time. In Hebrews 13:5, He has promised, "I will never leave you nor forsake you."

If you have received Jesus Christ just now, many things happened including the following:

- Jesus came into your life (Revelation 3:20).

- Your sins were forgiven (Colossians 1:14).
- You became a child of God (John 1:12).
- You received eternal life (John 5:24).
- You began the adventure for which God created you (John 10:10; 2 Corinthians 5:17).

Now thank Him for what He has done for you. You can say, "Thank you Lord Jesus for coming into my life, forgiving my sins and giving me eternal life." Amen.

The very act of thanking God expresses your faith. Welcome to God's Great family! In Mark 8:38 Jesus said, "Anyone who is ashamed of Me and My message in these days of unbelief and sin, I, the Messiah, will be ashamed of him when I return in the glory of My Father, with the holy angels." So, tell your friends what you did with Jesus today.

I encourage you to attend a near by church where Jesus is honored and the Bible is taught, so that you can continue to grow in your new found relationship with God
